

## TODAY WE CELEBRATE THE FEAST OF THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD!

Each year on this First Sunday after the Epiphany, we celebrate the Baptism of Our Lord.

This Feast is one of four occasions in the year designated by the Prayer Book as a baptismal day. (The other three are Easter, Pentecost, and All Saints' Day.) Each of the four days has its particular theme, which enhances our understanding of one aspect of the primary Christian sacrament, Holy Baptism.

Jesus' baptism was for all the Gospel writers and in the apostolic preaching of the Gospel, the event that initiated the redemptive ministry of the Messiah. It was in that event that Jesus was revealed as Messiah (Christ). God designated him as the beloved Son and he was anointed by the Holy Spirit. We renew our baptismal vows today in the context of this theme.

In Holy Baptism, each Christian is adopted as the child of God. Each Christian becomes a "messianic" person, anointed by the Holy Spirit. We do not simply become passive recipients of the benefits of Christ; we are "christed" or christened. We become sharers in his life and in his redemptive ministry.

# WE ALSO CELEBRATE A RITE OF COMMITMENT TO CHRISTIAN SERVICE

The Book of Common Prayer contains several Rites, or expressions of the church's relationship with God through word, symbol and action. One of those Rites is called a Commitment to Christian Service. "This form may be used when a person wishes to make or renew a commitment to the service of Christ in the world, either in general terms, or upon undertaking some special responsibility" (Book of Common Prayer, 420).

Today two St. Francis parishioners, Sophie Schaffer and Bill Thompson, will make a Commitment to Christian Service. Each of them have been in preparation and prayer for this day. Sophie is recommitting herself generally to her faith in Jesus Christ while Bill makes a particular commitment to serve as a Lay Pastoral Minister in our congregation. Both will each make an Act of Commitment during the Rite which articulates their intentions. They will then reaffirm their baptismal promises along with each of us. Finally, we will pray that we, too, may strengthen ourselves in our Christian vocation and in service to others.


Reader	A reading from the Book of Isaiah.	43:1-7

#### The Gospel

Deacon The Holy Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke. 3:15-17, 21-22

People Glory to you, Lord Christ.

As the people were filled with expectation, and all were questioning in their hearts concerning John, whether he might be the Messiah, John answered all of them by saying, "I baptize you with water; but one who is more powerful than I is coming; I am not worthy to untie the thong of his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fork is in his hand, to clear his threshing floor and to gather the wheat into his granary; but the chaff he will burn with unquenchable fire." Now when all the people were baptized, and when Jesus also had been baptized and was praying, the heaven was opened, and the Holy Spirit descended upon him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased."

### **RITE OF COMMITMENT TO CHRISTIAN SERVICE**

The Presider calls forward those seeking to renew their commitment to Christ. Standing before the congregation, they make an Act of Commitment. The Presider then prays:

Presider May the Holy Spirit guide and strengthen you, that in this, and in all things, you may do God's will in the service of the kingdom of his Christ.

People Amen.

Presider In the name of this congregation I commend you to this work, and pledge you our prayers, encouragement, and support.

Those making an Act of Commitment move to the baptismal font with the Presider to renew their baptismal vows.

### **RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL COVENANT**

- Deacon My siblings in Christ, through the Paschal mystery, we are buried with Christ by Baptism into his death, and raised with him to newness of life. I call upon you, therefore, on this feast of the Baptism of our Lord, to renew the sacred promises and vows of Holy Baptism, by which we once renounced evil and promised to serve God faithfully through God's holy Church.
- Deacon Do you believe and trust in God?
- People I believe and trust in God, creator of heaven and earth.
- Deacon Do you believe and trust in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?
- People I believe and trust in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord.

	He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.
Deacon	Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit?
People	I believe and trust in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.
Presider	How will you connect to Christ in community?
People	With God's help I will continue in the apostles' teaching and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in the prayers.
Presider	How will you resist evil and turn to Christ?
People	With God's help I will persevere in resisting evil, and, whenever I fall into sin, repent and return to the Lord.
Presider	How will you show Christ in your life?
People	With God's help I will proclaim by word and example the Good News of God in Christ.
Presider	How will you seek and serve Christ in your life?
People	With God's help I will seek and serve Christ in all persons, loving my neighbor as myself.
Presider	How will you work for the reign of God?
People	With God's help I will strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being.
Presider	How will you preserve God's creation?
People	With God's help I will cherish the wondrous works of God, and protect and restore the beauty and integrity of all creation.

Presider May Almighty God, the Eternal, who has given us a new birth by water and the Holy Spirit, and bestowed upon us the forgiveness of sins, keep us in eternal life by grace, in Christ Jesus our Lord.

People Amen.

The Presider sprinkles the people with holy water as a reminder of their baptism.

People	Amen.
	Almighty God, look with favor upon Sophie and Bill who have now reaffirmed their commitment to follow Christ and to serve in his name. 

and give himself for us, a fragrant offering.


Presider


### The Breaking of the Bread
